1. Take EXIT 12.

TROPHIES

The Lenape Tracking Club of Central New Jersey will present a rosette to each dog rated "passed" in the test.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

CLOSING DATE for the test is 12:00 p.m., Thursday, September 26, 2024, after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted.

ENTRIES shall be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached, and a drawing will be held within 48 hours of the closing to determine which entries will participate in the test.

ENTRIES will be drawn in the presence of the Tracking Test Committee at 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, September 26, 2024, at the home of the test secretary, 6546 Fleecydale Road, Carversville, PA. The drawing shall be completely at random among all the entries received, except that preference shall be given to those dogs which have not previously earned a Tracking Dog title. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be assigned a position on Alternate Lists corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. The Secretary shall then notify all entries of the results of the draw.

TEST WORKER OPTION AKC Test Worker Option will be used for this test. Test entrants who have worked at previous Lenape events must submit two worker certificates with their entry in order to be included in the Worker Draw.

ENTRY FEES include \$.50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 event service fee.

MAIL all entries with fees to: Anna Burbank, PO Box 130, Carversville, PA 18913. Entries not on official AKC entry forms & photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

TELEPHONED, TELEGRAPHED, UNSIGNED, OR ENTRIES WITHOUT FEES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. No entry shall be made and none accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee and will have to be made good with cash or a money order prior to showing. The Test Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

IF, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the test, **NO REFUND OF ENTRIES WILL BE MADE.**

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded, in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

BITCHES IN SEASON Entrants must notify the Test Secretary and judges that their bitch is in season prior to the drawing for tracks. Bitches in season will participate only after all other dogs have been tested.

REFUNDS. Entry Fees for an Alternate that does not participate in the Tracking Test shall be refunded within 7 days. In the event an accepted Entry withdraws after the closing date to allow an Alternate to replace said Entry, **THE ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED.** In the event an Accepted Entry withdraws after the closing date and there is no Alternate to replace said Entry, **THE ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.**

THE TRACKING TEST will begin promptly following a draw at 9:00 a.m.

EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS: The Club reserves the right to cancel the test in the case of extreme weather conditions. Entrants will be contacted, and a message will be on (215) 630-3198 if this becomes necessary.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Dogs entering mixed breed classes (eligible only in standalone Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials) should mark Breed as "MIXED BREED." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
