



This is not a tracking item. But it may be of interest to those with older dogs in good health. Suburban D.T.C. has initiated an activity for Senior Dogs, 8 yrs of age or older (6 yrs for larger breeds with shorter life expectancy) It is called Back Packing. The dog must walk with his or her owner, on leash, wearing a back pack, for a minimum of 20 miles. (Any increment thereof is acceptable during the completion of the 20 miles) The distance is tabulated at each walk using a pedometer. At least four seniors from SDTC have completed their 20 miles in 1985. They will be awarded a patch for their accomplishment at the Annual Dinner.

You may not want to follow a programed activity such as the above but it would be good for the dog to feel it is out there doing something interesting and useful instead of being left at home in the kennel when you go tracking. Why not bring him or her along with you and give the dog some exercise, fun and attention...which amounts to love.

P.S. During our walks we made some new friends because Celtic was wearing a back pack. People would stop and ask questions and take time to pet her.

Seven LTC members and a guest went on a tour of The Seeing Eye on Jan. 23rd., the weather was cooperative. They showed us a film narrated by Betty White about the work they do, then we toured the headquarters building, the training kennels, and were given a demonstration of obedience work and a guide dog walking around obstacles. If there is interest expressed in the future we can arrange for another tour, they are only held on Thursday Mornings and are booked months in advance.

The Forte's have received their fourth Seeing Eye puppy to raise, it is Greg's puppy, but raising a puppy is definitely a family project. This one is a female shepherd, jet black, named Gayle. Greg's last puppy Gine went back in January, her hips were X-rayed and rated "8" (scale of 1-9, 9 is the top), and she should start her training soon. When we were on the tour we saw her in the hospital kennel run (she'd only been back a week...she recognized me coming up the walk, but I couldn't go talk to to her). Gayle is ready to go for a walk...is it any wonder it takes forever to get things done around here.
