For those not familiar with the Elite Performer program, you must do a video with a script and a narrator, filming must be continuous and you need to incorporate ten advanced/performer level tricks, with a minimum of five with props - and you can't use standard obedience or agility equipment. It's supposed to be like a performance put on for entertainment at a school or nursing home - and you deal with the dog who shows up that day <G>.

On April 16 she earned her first CDX Q at the Williamsport Obedience Trial with a scoreof 181.5 and First Place. Next came her second Junior Hunter leg at the Navesink River Hunting Retriever Test held at Colliers Mills, NJ on April 25th.

At the Krusin' K-9 agility trial on May 1, handled by Caroline Le Bel, Jetta earned her second Excellent Jumpers leg and 2nd place. Caroline had not seen or practiced with her, for three years. The following day at the CDSP obedience trial, held at C&S County K9, she earned two scores of 196.5 in Novice. Both were 2nd places.

On June 10th, Carol Wyatt handled her in the breed class at Taconic Hills Kennel Club where Jetta earned BOS. It was her first time in the breed ring since Westminster 2020. The next day she was BOS again and she has completed her Silver Grand Championship.

Then over the weekend at the Taconic Hills Kennel Club's Obedience Trial Jetta obtained her second CDX leg with a 192 and 2nd place. On Sunday with a 191.5 and 3rd place she finished her CDX.

It has been great to be showing again, seeing old friends and meeting new ones. Dog friends are the very best.

I saw that the person who was the ring steward was videoing someone so I asked if she would mind videoing me with my camera. Her name was Kristin and she said "sure no problem". She ended up videoing all of my runs in open and utility for two days. Three weeks later I lost Dreamer to kidney failure. You never know when it's your last video.

Dreamer had accomplished so much in his almost nine years. He got his PT in herding, his open titles in agility, and his UDX and OM1 in AKC obedience. Dreamer really enjoyed showing in CDSP this past year, earning his OTCH just a month ago.

He also did some acting on TV and Movies. He had small bit parts on TV in Madam Secretary, New Amsterdam, and Orange is the new Black. He also played in Movies, 17 Bridges, and Batman the Joker. We did a lot of traveling together and he had been to more states than most people I know; visiting a total of 44 states along with 4 Canadian provinces. He had been from the Canadian Rocky Mountains to Florida, from Maine to California. We did a lot together, inside and outside the ring. I am so grateful for the time I had with him. He passed away very peacefully, on Friday June 4 at 2:45a.m, in my bed, with Joe and me holding his paws with my tears falling down on him. He will be sorely missed, but now Pilot must carry on. I think Dreamer was coaching him from above.
